

CERTIFICATE IN ARTIST DEVELOPMENT (ONLINE)

Overview

The Frost Online Certificate in Artist Development consists of 9, graduate-level credits that allow enrollees to pursue professional development as performing artists. Credits are earned by choosing three courses from a provided menu of five, 3-credit courses that must be completed within two years. This certificate may be applied toward a graduate degree for the individual who is later accepted into a degree program.

How To Apply

2. UPLOAD YOUR DOCUMENTS TO YOUR APPLICATION (<https://uonline.miami.edu/programs/master-arts-presenting-live-entertainment/admissions/>)

- Unofficial transcript: Submit a copy of your transcript from all academic institutions attended.
- Résumé: Submit your most recent résumé that appropriately illustrates your professional experience.
- Personal statement: Submit a one-page personal statement addressing your interest in the program in relation to your professional background and career aspirations.
- Language Proficiency: International students who do not hold an undergraduate U.S degree must submit Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) scores. Enter name and contact information for one (1) person who can comment on your professional ability in the online application (https://myonline.miami.edu/signup/?_ga=2.220224027.2074457241.1586183074-1670025083.1584388400).

Your reference automatically receives an email to fill out your recommendation online. You can then track the status of the recommendation in the system. Recommendations must be received by the application deadline to be considered for admissions.
