Students that meet the minimum requirements may be eligible to enroll in a maximum of 30 credit hours in an undergraduate, non-degree seeking category. Classes may be applied to certain degree programs, after all application and degree-seeking requirements are met. In order to be enrolled in this category, students submit an online application (http://www.miami.edu/asap/) with any required documents. A minimum 2.5 G.P.A. is required to continue in the program beyond 12 attempted credit hours.

Students that meet the minimum requirements may enroll in up to 6 credit hours (600/700 lecture classes only), **lifetime maximum**, in a graduate nondegree seeking category. Classes may be applied to certain degree programs, after all application and degree-seeking requirements are met. Not all graduate departments participate in this program. In order to enroll in this category, students submit an online application (http://www.miami.edu/ asap/), after securing the written permission of the participating graduate department.
