All music students will successfully complete:

- MCY 141 Musical Trends and Traditions, which will include substantial evaluated and revised writing components.
- MMI 445 Senior Project/Portfolio, this course is the capstone for both the CAM and MADE programs. Students will develop and compile a
 portfolio of creative works that showcase their individual artistry, including but not limited to recordings, videos, songs, scores, and/or other
 applicable media elements. Students will also be required to organize a public performance/showcase their works. Requisite: MADE Major or CAM
 Minor
- COS 333 Business Communication or ENG 200+ course (recommended courses ENG 230 or ENG 331)

Assessment

There will be at least 2 specific assessments in each Advanced Communication Skills course for communications or writing equivalent to 4000 words, evaluated and revised.
